


Sunpads, sofas and fine views make the flybridge a social centre of the boat



Not only is the Privilège Signature 580 an icon of innovative design and modern living. It is also a superbly effective sailing machine and a luxurious home on the ocean. Crafted by hand with the greatest expertise, the yacht features only premium materials to satisfy the demands and preferences of the owner.







Thanks to a carefully designed bulkhead helm station, all the sail controls are within easy reach of the helmsperson. Even on watch, the skipper remains in close contact with the rest of the crew in the open cockpit lounge just below and to the flydeck.

Harmony is the key to this boat – seamlessly blending the different spaces and activities on board State-of-the-art electronics reproduce all the key boat data at the helm and in the saloon below









A hard-top bimini option is available with glass panels that can easily be covered for shade

Lounging space is a key feature of this boat. A huge flybridge seating area with a coffee table allows the party to move upstairs into the open. And there's a breathtaking forward cockpit in the standard layout.



Across the length of nearly 60 feet, the Privilège Signature 580 features both a front and a rear cockpit. Exclusive, direct access to the owner's cabin turns the forward cockpit into a wonderful private refuge which you can reach comfortably and undisturbed in just a few steps.




Franck Darnet has designed a contemporary sofa area that is for serves meals and work – you can lowering the saloon table for coffee, games or watching TV.

The centrally situated chart table is home to state-ofthe-art navigation technology. It gives you a complete overview of the boat's systems and of navigation, all from the comfort of the saloon. With the comfortable galley-down layout, an exclusive lounge area enlarges the exquisite saloon to the dimensions of a loft apartment. Direct access to the front and rear cockpits creates the enchanting sense of a luxury penthouse at sea.









Time is the biggest luxury, and the space to enjoy it



Opt to put the galley down in the starboard hull, next to the crew cabin. This variant creates an impressive living and eating area in the saloon above, dedicated to private, comfortable living. All the hotel/crew space is also concentrated in a single hull.

Natural light, ventilation and even an extractor hood keep the galley comfortable



In fact, it's more of a kitchen than a traditional galley, with capabilities and styling that outshines many homes. Top-of-the-range equipment runs to a large electric oven and four-burner gas hob, lots of fridge and freezer space, coffee machines, microwave, dishwasher and more.







The layout on starboard makes for a larger galley with more worksurface space and storage units, for the cost of one guest cabin. There's also room for more refrigeration so that you can enjoy fresh food for longer on a bluewater cruise.
